



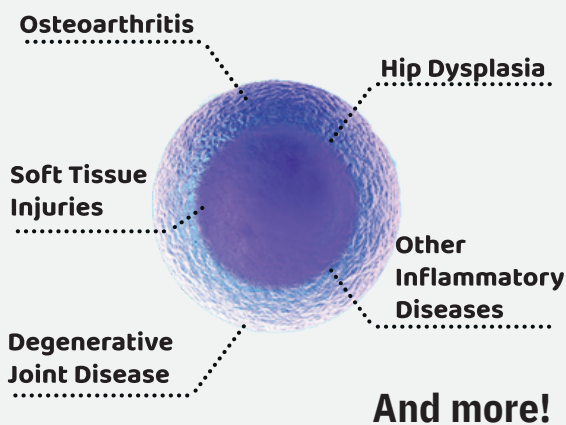
## Stem Cell & PRP Therapy For Pets Now Available!

PRP or Platelet Rich Plasma is a convenient same day treatment that harnesses the healing abilities of the patient's blood platelets. Veterinarians utilize the treatment in conjunction with common surgeries or as a part of treatment plans to combat injury and disease.

K9-ACV stands for Canine Autologous Cancer Vaccine. Using the therapeutic approach of immunotherapy, Ardent Animal Health has developed a cancer vaccine, customized to the patient's cancer type. This service can be added to any mass removal and includes a 72 hour diagnosis. The veterinarian will simply resect your pet's mass and send it to Ardent. If needed a cancer vaccine can be generated within 5 business days.

The process is simple, your veterinarian would remove fat tissue during a spay, neuter, or other surgery and send the sample to our lab to be processed and cryo-stored.

### What's the process?



**STEP 1:** Using the provided collection cooler, you will send in a tumor sample to our lab. An Overnight UPS shipping label is provided.



**STEP 2:** Our lab team will process the tumor sample and extract the tumor cells to prepare 3 dose vaccine.



**STEP 3:** Finished vaccine is shipped overnight back to your clinic and is administered every 30 days.

### What's the process?



**STEP 1:** Your Vet will surgically remove adipose tissue during a spay, neuter, or other elective surgery.



**STEP 2:** The sample is then shipped overnight to our lab and the sample will be processed.



**STEP 3:** Your pet's cells are then cryo stored for the life of your pet!
